



### Licensing requirements check list

Your application cannot be processed until **all** the required documents have been received.

**You may not practise veterinary medicine in Saskatchewan until you have been licensed by the Saskatchewan Veterinary Medical Association.**

- Completed application form, indicating the name of three references, two of whom must be licensed veterinarians. Initial each item on the line provided on page two of application form to confirm that it has been read and completed if necessary.
- Three letters of reference (referees to send directly to the SVMA)
  - Reference 1: \_\_\_\_\_

  - Reference 3: \_\_\_\_\_
- Letter(s) of standing from other licensing bodies, if applicable (licensing body to send directly to SVMA).
- Certificate of Qualification from the Canadian Veterinary Medical Association (CVMA).
- A certified true copy of your veterinary degree, signed by an SVMA member or notary public.
- Payment of applicable fees (as outlined in the membership fees document) by cheque/Visa or MasterCard.
