



Licensing requirements check list

Your application cannot be processed until **all** the required documents have been received.

You may not practise veterinary medicine in Saskatchewan until you have been licensed by the Saskatchewan Veterinary Medical Association.

- Completed application form. Initial each item on the line provided on page two of application form to confirm that it has been read and completed if necessary.
- Letter(s) of standing from other licensing bodies, if applicable (licensing body to send directly to SVMA).
- Certificate of Qualification from the Canadian Veterinary Medical Association (CVMA).
- A certified true copy of your veterinary degree, signed by an SVMA member or notary public.
- Payment of applicable fees (as outlined in the membership fees document) by cheque/Visa or MasterCard.
